This mission is accomplished empowering teen mothers through job training, psychological and emotional support, and comprehensive health care.

In a complementary way, Juanfe Foundation has programs to help children in critical health conditions, including some children of beneficiaries.

Teenage Mothers Program Phase I

In this phase, which lasts for six months, young mothers receive psychosocial guidance in 70% of the time and training in productive activities in the remaining 30%.

The transformation from vulnerable adolescents with low self-esteem into empowered women and with a life project was achieved in 2017. This was possible through psycho-affective strengthening based on the recognition of values and rights, healthy living habits and responsible sexuality.

They also received training in an art or trade (Kitchen, Beauty, Jewelery or Logistics) obtaining the necessary skills for their training process and for the improvement of their quality of life.

Teenage Mothers Extension Program Phase II

The second phase lasts for one year where young mothers are trained in one of the three lines of technical education (Hotel Services, Integral Beauty or International Cuisine) during 70% of the time. In the remaining 30%, they continue to receive psychosocial counseling.

In 2017, adolescent mothers were empowered, which allowed them to acquire the necessary skills for a position in the working world and the generation of stable income that improves their quality of life.

Additionally, these young women consolidated as women who manage their sexual life in a responsible manner.

Employment and Entrepreneurship Office - Phase III

The third phase aims to ensure that young women enter the formal labor market in suitable conditions, and provide feedback on the training provided by the Foundation in accordance with the monitoring with the employer.

Through the psychosocial assessments applied to graduates and follow-ups to employees, weaknesses to be reinforced through potentialization courses and workshops were identified. These addressed topics such as: Pro-activity at work, business advice, marketing and sales, among others.

Infant Development Center

It promotes the social, emotional and cognitive development of babies between 0 and 24 months, children of adolescent mothers linked to Juanfe's intervention and belonging to families with high socioeconomic vulnerability.

In 2017, 240 babies were benefited. They received concentrated assistance in three components:

Psychoaffective: Focused on strengthening the mother-child bond.
Stimulation: Works the motor, sensory, socio-affective and language area.
Educational: Aimed at mothers, where they are trained in healthy lifestyle.

Crib Sponsoring Program (PPC)

Through this program, interventions of great impact on health and nutrition were made that decreased the mortality in children.

At the same time, the parents of the children intervened in their care were trained to have healthy lifestyle habits and how to prevent illnesses. sponsored babies. 177 suffered malnutrition in different degrees

Juan Felipe Medical Center

The Juan Felipe IPS Medical Center, located within the facilities of the Foundation, provided comprehensive medical care to beneficiary adolescent mothers, their children, babies treated by the Crib Sponsoring Program, as well as an external population.

Medical care included: General Medicine, Gynecology, Obstetrics, Pediatrics, Dentistry, Nutrition, Physiotherapy, Vaccination, Specialized Clinical Laboratory and Obstetric and gynecological ultrasound. Medical checkup Photo: Duván Duque

Voces Vitales Foundation Panama

Voces Vitales Foundation started to work in 2015 with the Centro Las Claras program, located in the vulnerable area of Felipillo in Panama City.

The objective of this project, which is adapted from Juanfe's intervention model, comes from the need to address the problem of teenage pregnancy that affects 20% of girls in this country.

Soy Más Foundation Chile

Since 2017, Soy Más Foundation works to improve the quality of life of teenage mothers in Chile, adapting Juanfe's intervention model.

The pilot test is being carried out in Santiago in Pintana, a poor area with delinquency and drug addiction.

During the first semester they worked training 25 girls in technical careers like Customer Service, Hairdressing and Beauty Services, and Culinary Arts.

Next semester there will be 20 new beneficiaries, and 20 more on the second semester.



Juanfe Foundation Medellin

With the support of the public and private sector, we worked for the creation of Juanfe Foundation in Medellin in 2017.

The official inauguration was held on November 15th in Lussac Restaurant, with the attendance of the public sector, businessmen, media and our work team.

Juanfe Medellin will start working with 100 teenage mothers in August 2018.
